Mrs. Nancy Fleming

Hi, I'm Nancy Fleming. I just want to apologize I had jaw surgery so I'm not speaking as clearly as I normally would.

President Gallagher:

Bless you.

Mrs. Fleming:

Thanks, I need some help. I have a couple of questions. I don't know if this is the time to raise them. I have a concern about Mr. Jackson in the Middle School. My daughter was assigned to him for this year. I had the displeasure this summer to read his book. I thought his tone was horrendous. I thought his attitude towards administration, some who are sitting at this table today, was also horrendous. He seems, and again, I do not know the man, angry. I know quite a few people who have had him – students – even my cousins who are now out of school ten and eleven years. And, I'm concerned because apparently, he was a regular name caller. And, don't know, I understand you're under a legal obligation to have him back and teaching. As a teacher myself I certainly understand that. I'm just wondering if there have been any other thoughts about keeping him out of the classroom. Is there anything you have planned to do as I'm sure you are appalled by the book and the grammar as I was.

President Gallagher:

Well, I wish my wife was here. She would be at that microphone in a flash. I have been directed to make no comments.

Dr. Greenberg:

Ms. Fleming, I did see correspondence from you and, as Superintendent of Schools, I welcome correspondence from all parents on any subject.

Mrs. Fleming:

On a last note, know that there are so many parents who are afraid. I give you my name. I'll tell you my daughter; her name is Claire. And, it's scary that nobody wants to speak out because they're afraid that their kids will be hurt or retaliated against. And, I think that as far as being a member (words not clear on tape here), a PTA member, a teacher myself — outside of this district — and also a long time Long Beach resident, that's not a good way to live in this community and it's not the community I know. I spoke to at least ten people and eight of the ten said, "Yeah, don't want to get involved because of that."

Board Member Gergen:

I just would like to say one neutral thing. Having been an extremely vocal member of PTA for 17 years, I never had one instance of any teacher retaliating against any of my children. And, I wish that parents would have the faith in our staff, in our administrators, to know that they have the right to speak out about what's important and advocating for their children in every way and I cannot imagine and, I'm telling you, never did I have retaliation and I really was quite vocal.

Board Member Alvarado

This is a different case, Lynn. And, we appreciate your honesty and you standing up here and having the courage to do that. I'm sure Dr. Greenberg can, if you want to switch your daughter out of that class, can listen to that.

Mrs. Fleming

It's not about that. That's not who I am. I'm not a whiner; I'm not a complainer; I don't ask for special favors ever. My daughter, my eldest daughter, is going off to college. She had a fabulous education here. Again, I don't doubt that. I don't even doubt that he's a good teacher at what he does. What I do doubt is that, on 26 charges, and a lot of them were against individual kids, that was disturbing. I don't know; I wasn't there. The tone of that book, some of the things that he said, his sexual escapade – one – all of that disturbed me. And, you know how people talk and kids only get half the story and I think that's a shame and I think that there'll be a lack of respect and/or fear and I think that will impugn the learning process. And, that's all I have to say.

Board Member Lester

I will say I've been on the Board for a long time. I have been at odds with the teachers more than anybody else and I have three kids. I have one (in college) and two children in the school and I have never, never seen any – even a hint of any type of retaliation. You know what ...I..

Mrs. Fleming I don't believe it either.

Board Member Lester
Yeah, I think our teachers are incredibly professional.

Mrs. Fleming I absolutely agree with that.

Board Member Lester

And, I know at the Board, we would not tolerate that. No ifs, ands or buts, we would not tolerate that. And, any parent who has something to say, please encourage them to say it. They can say it as publicly as they want and they should never, ever fear – or privately – yes. And, they should never fear any retaliation. We will not put up with that.

Mrs. Fleming

I'm not going to encourage anyone who feels uncomfortable. I just wanted to let it be known that that was the response personally that I got from people I know and I wanted to let you know that it's not just me.
